LIGHT@9 Children is for age 4 through 5th grade, and meets on the lower level of the church in Vincent Hall, near the parking lot entrance. LIGHT@9 Youth is for grades 6-12, and meets on the second floor near the offices, in the Youth Room. If you haven't registered yet, there are forms on the table in the rear of the sanctuary or at the Trinity Sunday table.

Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5–13. It resumes next Sunday. September 17. It is offered during the worship service starting on the third Sunday in September to the end May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door to the right of the sanctuary around the corner.
