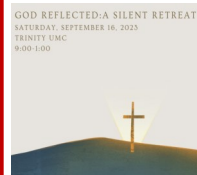
Single Together

The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes for Children 4 yrs. - high school is on break until September 17 and will meet at 9 a.m. on Sunday mornings. LIGHT@9 (Learning in God's House Together at 9 a.m.), is for age 4 years—through grade 5. It usually meets downstairs in Vincent Hall through the 3rd Sunday to May. Our youth classes meet upstairs, middle school in the Youth Room and high school in the classroom down from the church office. You can register by picking up a form in the back of the sanctuary.

Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 7–12. It is on break until September 17. It is usually offered during the worship service on **Sundays, the third Sunday in September to May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday.** It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door to the right of the sanctuary around the corner.
