Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs. Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs. is open, under the caring direction of Madeline Jarvinen, every Sunday from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m., for children ages birth to 4. The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes for Kindergarten - Grade 12 is at 9 a.m. We meet Sundays through the end of May except for special holidays. LIGHT@9 Children is for Kindergarten—through grade 5. It meets downstairs in Vincent Hall near the parking lot entrance **LIGHT**@9 Youth is for grades 6-12 and meets on the second floor near the offices, in the Youth Room. Registration form are in the rear of the sanctuary.

Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5-13. It is offered during the worship service on Sundays until the end of May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Comunion Sunday. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door to the right of the sanctuary around the corner.

The Dance Movement Choir is open to all ages and abilities. We rehearse on Sundays in the sanctuary from 12:00-12:45 p.m. and 12:45-1:30 p.m. We share movement / dance / ASL pieces in the worship service during the year.
