## SUNDAY MORNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN

The Children's Table offers Children's Bulletins for readers & non-readers coloring pages and other materials to help children feel welcome and comfortable in church. The table is located in the rear of the sanctuary. Please return supplies.

Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs. is open, under the caring direction of Shaylee Geier and Madeline Jarvinen, every Sunday from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m., for children ages birth to 4. The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes for Children 4 yrs. - high school is on hiatus until September and usually meets at 9 a.m. on Sunday mornings. LIGHT@9 (Learning in God's House Together at 9 a.m.), is for age 4 years—through grade 5. It usually meets downstairs in Vincent Hall from September to May Except for Easter and Christmas through the third Sunday in January and the Summer. Our youth classes meet upstairs, middle school in the Youth Room and high school in the classroom down from the church office.

Our Adult Class meets in the Hale Room downstairs Sundays, from 9-10 a.m. and is still happening throughout the summer. Questions, email tumcadultce@trinityspringfield.org.

Bible Story for Kids Ages 4-8 is on hiatus until September and usually meets on Sundays except on Communion Sunday and Easter downstairs beginning at the second hymn. Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 7–12. It is on hiatus until September. It is usually offered during the worship service on Sundays, September to May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday and Easter. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door on the right of the sanctuary around the corner.
