LIGHT@9 (Learning in God's House Together at 9 a.m.), is for age 4 years-through grade 5. It usually meets downstairs in Vincent Hall from September to May. Our youth classes meet upstairs, middle school in the Youth Room and high school in the classroom down from the church office.

Chapel Kids is on break until September 17. It is usually offered during the worship service on Sundays, September to May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door on the right of the sanctuary around the corner.
