Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs. Our Nursery Care provider will be away today, Sunday, August 10. The nursery space will be open for parents and children to use but will be unsupervised, so parents/guardians will need to stay with children in the nursery. The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes for Children 4 yrs. - high school is on break until September 17 and will meet at 9 a.m. on Sunday mornings. LIGHT@9 (Learning in God's House Together at 9 a.m.), is for age 4 years—through grade 5. It usually meets downstairs in Vincent Hall from **September to May**. Our youth classes meet upstairs, middle school in the Youth Room and high school in the classroom down from the church office.

Chapel Kids is on break until September 17. It is usually offered during the worship service on **Sundays, September to May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday.** It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door on the right of the sanctuary around the corner.

This church is committed to providing a safe place for our children & youth. Our Safe Sanctuaries Policy requires that parents (or an adult they have designated) bring & pick-up their children 5th gr. & under from church-sponsored programs. Please escort your child to/from the restrooms during worship.
