**Sunday Morning Adult Education Class**

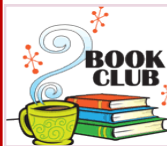

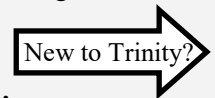


**Trinity Name Tags**

**Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs.** is open, under the caring direction of Shaylee Geier and Madeline Jarvinen, every Sunday from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m., for children ages birth to 4. The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

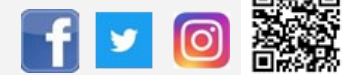

It is on hiatus until September.** It is usually offered during the worship service on **Sundays, September to May, except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday and Easter**. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door on the right of the sanctuary around the corner.
