Jim Sharrard's photos of past Boar's Head Festivals will be exhibited in the gallery during the month of January. Stop by to take a look!



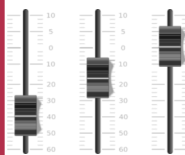
Order A Name Tag on Sundays

SUNDAY MORNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN

The Children's Table offers coloring pages and other materials to help children feel welcome and comfortable in church. The table is located in the rear of the sanctuary. Please return supplies.

Trinity's Nursery & Child Care for children birth-4 yrs. is open during the worship service.

Trinity has a dedicated staff member responsible for providing a safe and engaging atmosphere for children during services. Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5-13 yrs.

Chapel Kids is on break until Sunday, February 1, 2026. It usually runs mid-September through mid-May every Sunday except Communion Sunday, which is the first Sunday of every month. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel which is through the side door in the front right of the sanctuary around the corner.
