Chapel Kids is on break until Sunday, February 8, 2026. It usually runs mid-September through mid-May every Sunday except Communion Sunday, which is the first Sunday of every month. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel which is through the side door in the front right of the sanctuary around the corner.
