Plan to stop in the Community Gallery after the worship service today to view the Scantic River Artists and Artisans exhibit.



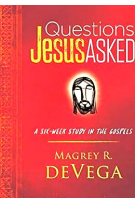
Angel Tree

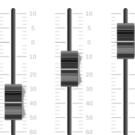
Accessibility Project

LIGHT@9 Sundays runs through mid-May. **LIGHT@9-Children** is for Kindergarten through grade 5. **LIGHT@9-Youth** is for gr. 6-12. Sign-up at the back of the Sanctuary or in front of the classrooms next Sunday.

Trinity's Nursery & Child Care for children birth-4 yrs. is open during worship.

Trinity has a dedicated staff member responsible for providing a safe and engaging atmosphere for children during services. Cody Minahan has worked in the education field for over 10 years with experience ranging from preschool all the way up to high school! We also have a weekly volunteer. An usher can direct you.

Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5–13 yrs.

Chapel Kids runs Sundays through mid-May, except Communion Sunday, which is the first Sunday of every month. It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door in the front right of the sanctuary around the corner.
