<u>Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs.</u> is open under the caring direction of Madeline Jarvinen every Sunday from 9 a.m. -12 p.m., for children ages birth to 4. The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes for Kindergarten - Grade 12. We meet on Sundays at 9 a.m. through the end of May. LIGHT@9-Children is for Kindergarten—through grade 5. It meets downstairs in Vincent Hall near the parking lot entrance LIGHT@9-Youth is for gr. 6-12 and meets on the top floor.
