

Trinity has a dedicated staff member responsible for providing a safe and engaging atmosphere for children during services. Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5–13 yrs.

Chapel Kids is offered on Sundays mid-September until the end of May, **except Communion Sunday, which is on the first Sunday of every month.** It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door in the front right of the sanctuary around the corner.
