



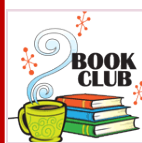
Sunday Night Youth Fellowship - Today, Sunday, April 21, 6:00 p.m.

Trinity's Nursery for children ages birth to 4 yrs. is open, under the caring direction of Madeline Jarvinen, every Sunday from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m., for children ages birth to 4. The nursery is located on the lower level of the building. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes for Kindergarten - Grade 12. We meet on Sundays at 9 a.m. through the end of May. **LIGHT@9-Children** is for Kindergarten—through grade 5. It meets downstairs in Vincent Hall near the parking lot entrance **LIGHT@9-Youth** is for gr. 6-12 and meets on the top floor.

Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5–13. It is offered during the worship service on Sundays until the end of May, **except on the first Sunday of the month which is Communion Sunday.** It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door to the right of the sanctuary around the corner.

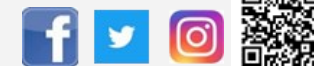
