Trinity has a dedicated staff member responsible for providing a safe and engaging atmosphere for children during worship services. Trinity member, Ashby Pack is Trinity's new Nursery Care Giver. We also have a weekly volunteer. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes LIGHT@9 for K-Grade 12 Meet Sundays at 9:00 a.m.

LIGHT@9-Children, for Kindergarten-through grade 5, meets downstairs in Vincent Hall. **LIGHT@9-Youth**, for gr. 6-12, meets on the top floor. The classes run on Sundays, Mid-September to Mid-May.

Chapel Kids is a worship service designed for children Ages 5-13 yrs.

Chapel Kids is offered on Sundays mid-September until the end of May, **except Communion Sunday, which is the first Sunday of the month.** It begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. It is located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door in the front right of the sanctuary around the corner.
