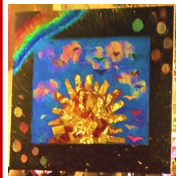
Save the Date! The Much-Loved Carillon Concerts Return on Thursday, July 2!

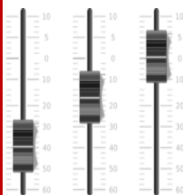
Interchurch Softball

SUNDAY MORNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN

The Children's Table offers coloring pages and other materials to help children feel welcome and comfortable in church. The table is located in the rear of the sanctuary. Please return supplies.

Trinity's Nursery for children birth to 4 yrs. is open during the worship service.

Trinity has a dedicated staff member responsible for providing a safe and engaging atmosphere for children during worship services. Trinity member, Ashby Pack is Trinity's new Nursery Care Coordinator. We also have a weekly volunteer. An usher can direct you.

Trinity's Christian Education Classes LIGHT@9 are on Hiatus until Mid-September.

You can sign up Mid-September for fall 2026 classes. **LIGHT@9-Children**, for Kindergarten-through grade 5, usually meets downstairs in Vincent Hall. **LIGHT@9-Youth**, for gr. 6-12, usually meets on the top floor. The classes will run on Sundays from mid-September through mid-May.

Chapel Kids, a worship service for children Ages 5-13 years is on Hiatus until Mid-September.

Chapel Kids usually begins at the beginning of the middle hymn, and ends after the benediction. When it resumes it will be located in Grace Chapel, which is through the side door in the front right of the sanctuary around the corner.
