

Dear Trinity Family,

Grace and peace to each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ.

Recently, Trinity's Covid-19 Ad Hoc Committee (TCAC), which has been empowered by Ad Council to make interim decisions during this pandemic, met and has agreed to restart in-person worship services, starting Sunday, September 13th. We will also return to our regular worship time of 10:30 a.m.

Due to safety guidelines, we are still asking people to wear their masks during worship, keep their 6-foot social distance when gathering, and otherwise conform with the church's Phase 2 reopening plan which was adopted by the Administrative Council on June 18, 2020. Furthermore, we are limiting the number of people allowed in the sanctuary to 75. Accordingly, we have designated Asbury Hall as an overflow worship space, where people will be able to watch our worship livestreamed. Asbury Hall can hold a maximum of 30 people. Ushers will be able to guide you during that time.

For those who are not yet able to join us for in-person worship. We are providing two virtual options so you can still join us. 1) we will begin LIVESTREAMING our worship services, also at 10:30 a.m. on Sundays, starting September 13th; and/or 2) you can watch the recording later on Sundays. We hope these measures will provide safe worship opportunities for as many of our members as possible. Of course, should any of the various official guidance or requirements change, amendment of this current plan may occur.
